The procurement Manager provides strategic, high-level analysis and support to the General Manager, the Management team and the Board of Directors of the Grenada Airports Authority (GAA) from a procurement perspective; ensures the implementation of all relevant regulations, rules, processes and procedures governing the procurement at the GAA; plans, directs and controls the day to day functions of the department and collaborates with other department managers and stakeholders to ensure that all departments adhere to the approved procurement measures.
